
have seemed to adapt so far with some adjustments from our volunteers and most of our members. Lets keep it up.

Covid Reminder - (Excerpt from the CoVid-019 Operation Plan and Rules)

Note: As we go to press, food and beverage service is limited to the patio area. Please be kind to our volunteer staff.

- 1. The maximum capacity of the Lodge at any time is 75 people. This has been determined by the Fire Marshall of the City of Farmington Hills. Currently our capacity is reduced by 50%, meaning that no more than 37 people may be in the Lodge at any given time. This includes employees.
- 2. The Patio can accommodate more Members however, you must follow the 6' social distancing guidelines.
- 3. The Lodge will only be available to members in good standing (as well as household members) during the limited occupancy period. To gain entry, you must display a current member and/or spouse card. **Sorry but, no guests are allowed at this time.**
- 4. Members/spouses are required to wear masks upon entering and when moving around the building. Masks are available upon request if you do not have one. Once you reach your seat you may remove your mask to eat and/or drink. Mask use is required by the State of Michigan and Oakland County Health Division.


