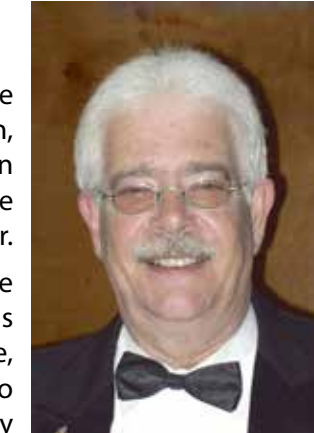
For all that attended the Friendsgiving Dinner, it was wonderful! Thank you, Christie, for all of your hard work, and to all of your little helpers. A very successful evening!

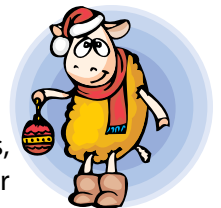
