The officers we elect to oversee operations and funding put in a lot of time and energy to manage our Lodge and strive to improve operations. These roles demand a commitment of time but the reward is seeing our Lodge grow and knowing that our charitable works are making lives better in our community. From the outside, it can seem intimidating to volunteer to run for office: Have I been a member long enough? Do I even understand how the Elks work? Do I know our Lodge well enough? Worry not! If you believe you have something to contribute, please step forward. Current and past officers and long-time members are always here to help. Your Lodge needs you!

Important update on bar and kitchen operations: As you know, our Lodge is an all-volunteer operation. Our bartenders and cooks give of their time to keep our clubroom open and to care for our equipment and space. But the reality is that not everything can – or even should – be left to volunteers. Some tasks are too time-consuming to squeeze into a regular volunteer shift and some tasks have to be done with the bar and kitchen closed. The House Committee has developed a task list and is seeking members interested in taking on one or more of these tasks on a regular basis at a pay rate of \$20 per hour. The task list will be posted on both bulletin boards and interested members are asked to call Cris Doby or Christie Korczyk for more information or to sign up.

Annual Elections Farmington Elks Lodge

Nominations of Lodge Officers will take place on Feb. 1st, starting at 7:30pm, during the Lodge meeting. If needed, elections will be during the Feb. 15th meeting. Both nominations and voting are conducted under New Business by Members in attendance.

If only one person is nominated for a position during the First Meeting, the position is considered filled and the nominee elected. If two or more people are nominated for a position, a vote will be taken during the Second Meeting of the month.

In addition:

- Nominations are made verbally on the Lodge Floor.
- Seconding of a nomination is not required.
- Proxies and/or absentee votes are not allowed.
- The person being nominated is not required to be present.
- Declining a nomination needs to be done before the Second Meeting.


