

## Placing Commemorative Wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier

With the support of the Board, PER Cris Doby applied to Arlington National Cemetery for our Lodge to place a commemorative wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Solider. Our request was approved and we are honored to have been assigned to place a wreath on Saturday, April 13, 2024. All Lodge members are encouraged to consider a trip to DC to be present for the ceremony. While the official delegation is limited to four persons, there is space for everyone to be present as witness to this solemn event.

We were approved to have professional videography of the ceremony and the two professional filmmakers who have helped out at King of Diamonds every Friday have agreed to travel to DC to document the ceremony. This will be shared with all of our Members and then with Elks nationally.

All members of the delegation will travel at their own expense but the Board is asking our Members to help support the expenses associated with the filming and the purchase of the wreath. These expenses are in the range of \$800, of which \$350 has been anonymously donated. We are seeking to raise an additional \$450.

During the month of March, those who donate \$8 or more will have their names printed on flag decals to be displayed in the Lodge. These flags will then accompany our delegation to DC and be attached to the underside of the commemorate wreath when it is placed at the Tomb. If you prefer not to have your name made public, you may donate through envelopes that will be available in the Lodge. We will also have a 50/50 raffle fundraiser at our St. Patrick's Day dinner.

It is in the very DNA of the Elks to support and honor those who have served in our nation's military. Thank you for all you do through ENF to support our veterans. Your additional generosity during March will allow our Lodge to express our devotion in this extraordinary way.
