Notice of Proposed By-Law Change

At the regular Lodge meeting on Sept. 15, 2021 a revision to the Lodge By-Laws was proposed in writing, read on the floor, and laid over for a vote.

Current By-Law:

ARTICLE IV: MEETINGS

Section 1. The regular Lodge meetings of this Lodge shall be held on the third Wednesday of each month throughout the year. If a regular meeting falls on a holiday, that meeting shall be held on the same day of the week during the following week. In February, March and April, the lodge will meet on the first and third Wednesday of each month.

Section 2. The regular hour of meeting shall be 8:00PM; but at any time, however, the regular meeting may be held at an hour to be determined by vote of the Lodge to that effect at the previous meeting, provided that written notice of such change of meeting hour shall be given to all the Members.

Proposed Change:

ARTICLE IV: MEETINGS

Section 1. The regular Lodge meetings of this Lodge shall be held on the <u>first and third</u> Wednesday of each month throughout the year. If a regular meeting falls on a holiday, that meeting shall be held on the same day of the week during the following week. <u>In July and August, the lodge will meet on the third Wednesday of each month.</u>

Section 2. The regular hour of meeting shall be <u>7:30PM</u>; but at any time, however, the regular meeting may be held at an hour to be determined by vote of the Lodge to that effect at the previous meeting, provided that written notice of such change of meeting hour shall be given to all the Members.

By order of the acting Exalted Ruler, discussion and voting on the proposed change will take place at the regular Lodge meeting, convening at 8pm, on October 20,2021.


