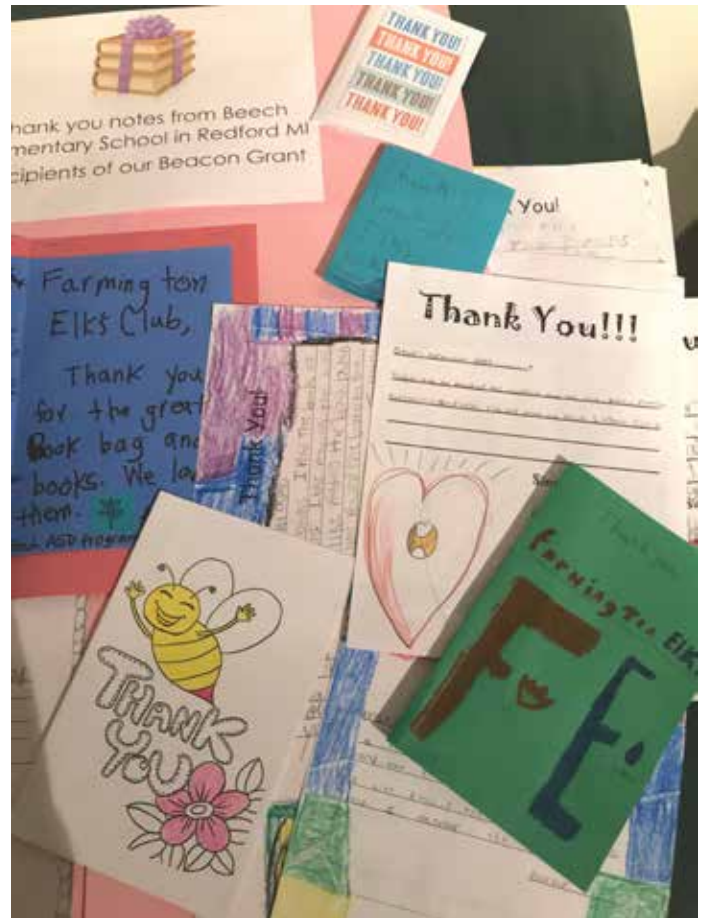

Grants Awarded

This year, Beech Elementary School (Redford Union District) received a \$2,000 grant from the Farmington Elks to give students access to equipment in order to engage in distance learning. In addition, the Redford Union School District is providing "Mobile Math Kits" to the students at Beech Elementary. These kits contain learning aids such as counting beads, dice, variously shaped tiles and measuring tools for at-home learning.

Last year the Farmington Elks used a similar grant to purchase books needed by the Beech Elementary students in order to help them engage in learning through reading. Appreciative students made Thank You notes (see photo) which were sent to the Lodge.

The Volunteers of America (VOA) is the beneficiary of a second \$2,000 Spotlight Grant. The funds will be used to assist veterans in getting needed furniture and household goods when moving from temporary to permanent housing. The grant should assist 3 veterans in this effort. Members of the Lodge will accompany a member of the VOA staff in selecting the items at the Fifth Avenue Furniture location in Detroit. The store is partnering with the VOA and the Farmington Elks in an effort to maximize the funds and show gratitude to our veterans.
