From the ER:

Remembering September 11, 2001

8:46 AM - American Airlines Flight 11 from Boston, bound for Los Angeles, crashed into the World Trade Center's North Tower, between the 93rd and 99th floors.

9:03 AM - United Airlines Flight 175, also headed from Boston to L.A., crashed into the World Trade Center's South Tower, between the 77th and 85th floors.

9:37 AM - American Airlines Flight 77, bound from the Washington area to L.A., crashed into the western side of the Pentagon.

9:59 AM - The South Tower collapsed.

10:03 AM - United Flight 93, headed to San Francisco from Newark, New Jersey, crashed into an empty field near Shanksville, Pennsylvania.

10:28 AM - The North Tower collapsed.

The attacks caused the deaths of 2,996 people and injured more than 6,000 others. More than ninety countries lost citizens in the attacks.

The repercussions of that day continue to shape national and international policy. The events of that day and days following are seared into the memories of all who bore witness. Twenty years have passed. An entire generation. We bear the duty of remembrance.

Scholarship News

2022 MVS Contest

The 2022 application is open. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need.

Eligibility: Current high school seniors, or the equivalent, who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply. Applicants do not need to be related to a member of the Elks. High school graduates are not eligible to apply. Applicants must be citizens of the United States on the date their applications are submitted; permanent legal resident status does not qualify.

2022 Legacy Awards Contest

The 2022 contest and applications open on September 1, 2021. The deadline for 2022 applications is February 7, 2022. For the 2022 contest, any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2019, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2019, is eligible to apply. The Elk must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2022. Great-grandchildren are not eligible.

The applicant must be a high school senior. The applicant must apply online only. Deadline is February 7, 2022. If the applicant's parent and grandparent are both Elk members, the applicant must apply through the parent's Elks Lodge. We have waived the standardized test requirement for the 2022 Legacy contest. You do not need to submit ACT and/or SAT scores.

Students may apply for more than one ENF scholarship; however, they may win only one. In cases where the student wins more than one, we will award the scholarship with the greater value. Students can accept local and state scholarships, which are separate from the awards at the national level.
